It is asked that speakers be respectful to each other, Team members, the principal and school district staff. Speakers that are disruptive will be asked to leave the meeting.



- Kindergarteners' percentage is concerning at 36%. Beatty, in all grades, is at 22% chronic absenteeism compared to CCSD which is 25%.


i. 2022-2023 Beatty 1.1% improvement
