FYI Changes to the SOT team

As a result of the passage of SB282 in the 2023 Legislative Session, effective July 1st, 2024, the principal is now a voting member on the SOT.

Now that the principal is a voting member, the SOT must add 1 additional parent to the team so that the parents make up 50% of the voting members.

Additionally, under the new law, the SOT has authority to pass the Plan of Operation for the school by a vote of at least 75%.

Principals now have 24 months to spend their carryover dollars. Finally, the SOT has more authority in selecting a new principal in the event the principal leaves the school.

Since the changes just went into effect last month, it's possible you may not have already heard. Below is a short podcast about the changes.
